As the subject of a Child Protection background check, your rights include:

- to be informed that Perpich Center for Arts Education will request this check for becoming or continuing as an employee or volunteer, and to determine whether you have been convicted of any of the above specified crimes, and
- to be informed of the BCA's response and obtain a copy of the report from Perpich Center for Arts Education
- to obtain from the BCA any record that forms the basis for the report, and
- to challenge the accuracy and completeness of any information contained in the report, and
- to be informed whether Perpich Center for Arts Education has denied your application because of the BCA's response and not to be required directly or indirectly to pay the cost of the background check.
