STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

As part of the Perpich Center for Arts Education's plans to survey all core arts curriculum content areas, we are conducting the Minnesota Arts Education Survey. This survey is the first time the Perpich Center for Arts Education has collected detailed information from each school about implementation of the Minnesota Academic Standards in the Arts K-12.

The Minnesota Arts Education Survey is part of the Perpich Center's *Arts Education in Minnesota Schools Research Project* funded by the Minnesota Legislature through its Arts and Cultural Heritage Fund. ***In addition to the Minnesota Department of Education (MDE), the Minnesota Arts Education Survey is being endorsed by the Minnesota Elementary School Principals Association (MESPA) and the Minnesota Association of Secondary School Principals (MASSP).*** The Perpich Center has contracted with *Quadrant Arts Education Research*, a national research and evaluation firm with significant experience in the construction of state-level surveys about arts education to implement the Minnesota Arts Education Survey. This project will provide schools, policy makers, and community leaders with an analysis of arts education while at the same time *providing schools and communities with tools and resources to strengthen student learning in and through the arts.*

Results of this survey will be previewed in the fall of 2011 with a final report presented in spring 2012. These results will help the Perpich Center for Arts Education, the Minnesota Department of Education and Minnesota's education stakeholders understand the impact of the Minnesota Academic Standards in the Arts on school programs, the level of student involvement with the arts, and how to align resources to areas of need.
